- ENTRY FEE:** \$65 Per event covers Targets, Referees, Fees and Awards
- AWARDS:** \$4.00 of each entry to Champion (At least \$20 more than highest class winner)
\$8.00 of each entry return to class. Gun Champion removed from class.
- H.O.A. (\$10)** \$10 (\$3.00 to Champion. \$7.00 return to class). HOA based on your 20ga average.
- OPTIONS:** \$5.00 on each 50, \$15 total. High gun system. All options remain in class.
- CLASS PURSE:** \$10 split 60/40 High gun system. Less than 5 in class, winner take all.
- TIES:** Ties will be shot off, double 3-4-5-4-3 etc. total by station. Malfunction rules suspended. Shooters supply own ammunition.
